

Wireless Internet Connection Policy

Welcome to Huntington Memorial Library's wireless Internet connection. This service is provided free of charge on an "as is" basis subject to the terms and conditions of use as follows:

- Huntington Memorial Library's Internet and Computer Use Policy applies to any use of the library's wireless access.
- Users are expected to use the wireless network in a responsible manner. Examples of inappropriate use include but are not limited to transmission or viewing child pornography, obscenity, harmful material, fraud, hacking, spamming, and illegal downloading or use of copyrighted material.
- Information passing through the library's wireless access is not secure and could be monitored, captured, or altered by others.
- Library staff is unable to provide technical assistance. The library assumes no responsibility for laptop configurations, security, or changes to data files resulting from connecting to the library's network. There is no guarantee that you will be able to make a wireless connection.
- It is the wireless user's sole responsibility to protect his/her information from all risks associated with the Internet, including any damage, loss, or theft that may occur as a result of using the library's wireless access.
- The library assumes no responsibility for the safety of the user's equipment. Do not leave your equipment unattended.
- In using this wireless Internet access, the user agrees and hereby releases, indemnifies, and holds harmless Huntington Memorial Library and its employees from any damage that may result in his/her use of the wireless access.
