LIBRARY MISSION

To provide a safe place for life-long learning and collaborative activities.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The following principles are the foundation for the library's mission and will guide us in our interactions with the community:

- Life-long learning is the foundation of a democratic society.
- Informational resources should be freely accessible to all people in the community.
- Community members should have a safe place to read, research and participate in all forms of life-long learning.

STRATEGIC GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Library as a resource

Goal 1. To inspire the Oneonta community to discover information in all formats by providing a relevant collection of materials and access to information beyond the library walls.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Maintain a print collection based on the reading preferences of the community.
 - a. Modify collection development to better align with the Master Plan.
- 2. Create Reader's Advisory information for our reading patrons.
 - a. Help patrons locate and discover new materials by using displays and other outreach strategies.
 - b. Educate library staff about new collections, genres and reading resources.
 - c. Continue to explore technology tools to enhance our ability to assist patrons.
- 3. Expand the promotion of digital books and the training required to master downloading.
- 4. Manage the local history collection and access to the community.
 - a. Develop a collection development policy to provide guidance to building a collection that is useful to the community.
 - b. Digitize high use collections to make them more accessible.
 - i. Participate in New York Heritage online archives project.
 - ii. Collaborate with other like-minded organizations.

Goal 2. To provide life-long learning opportunities through enriching educational programs for all ages.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Conduct regular story times for all ages of youth.
 - a. Reach out to nursery schools, Head Start and the summer Free Lunch programs.
- 2. Provide a wide variety of adult programming to meet the varied needs of the Oneonta community.
 - a. Provide leadership, regular meeting space and outside speakers for the thriving Writer's Program.
 - b. Utilize passive programming like Make It Mondays.
 - c. Bring experts in a variety of fields to the library to support lifelong learning.
 - d. Continue to respond to community needs so relevant programs can be provided.
- 3. Better align program funding with the heavy emphasis placed on program development.

Goal 3. To foster a community of makers by providing access to state of the art technology and maker equipment.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Create a circulating Library of Things that will consist of a wide variety of maker equipment.
- 2. Provide programs that allow patrons to explore new equipment that will enable an increase in skills and an understanding of a wide range of maker equipment.

3. Deliver digital literacy programs to youth and adults to increase awareness, knowledge and mastery of a complex technological world.

The Library as a place

Goal 4. To create a thriving library space where the community gathers, accesses library resources and attends programs.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Honor the Oneonta community's great love of the library building while updating the interior to better reflect the 21st century uses.
 - a. Renovate the 1st floor of the library as recommended in the Master Plan.
 - b. Update electrical and network cables.
- 2. Investigate adding a satellite space to expand the extremely limited square footage and to better provide quality library services.
- 3. Implement the park improvement plan to enhance the community's use of a treasured park in the city center.
- 4. Conduct an architect/engineer assessment of the building.

The Library as a community collaborator

Goal 5. To foster community connections by building partnerships and collaborations with organizations, businesses, and institutions.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Collaborate with local business organizations to foster cooperation and build a more robust network of library supporters.
- 2. Partner with other organizations that have similar educational missions to add value to the library's mission.
- 3. Increase the community's awareness of the life-long learning opportunities at the library.
 - a. Outreach to other locations by bringing digital services to the community with Pop-up Libraries in cafes, colleges, retirement centers, etc.
